**MOTION FOR SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
INITIAL BRIEF OF RESPONDENT AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Respondent, the State, moves this Court for an additional thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter. This is Respondent's second request for an extension of time in which to file the brief. In support of the request, undersigned counsel would respectfully show the Court:

1. Undersigned counsel for Respondent has been scheduled for a number of state and federal matters in the last thirty (30) days, that include, but are not limited to, the following: prepared and filed returns and memoranda of law in support of motion for summary judgment in four (4) habeas actions in Federal District Court (*Billy N. Lee, Sean D. Wells, Derrick T. Blake, and Clifford C. Campbell*); prepared and filed the return and memorandum of law in support of motion for summary judgment in another federal habeas action involving a four (4) volume appendix and voluminous state court record (*Anthony L. Mann*); prepared and filed a supplemental return and memorandum in support of cross-motion for summary judgment in response to an order from U.S. District Magistrate Judge Mary G. Baker (*Jimmy L. Duncan*);

and, prepared and filed a response in opposition to motion to appoint counsel in another habeas action (*Jose Luis Gutierrez Hernandez*). In addition, Counsel reviewed and filed a final brief of respondent in a non-capital murder direct appeal in this Court (*Shelton Butler*), has been perfecting her initial brief in another matter in this Court (*Walker Hughes*), and has been working with co-counsel on a proposed order of dismissal in a pending capital post-conviction relief matter (*Stephen Stanko*).

2. Due to her case load, undersigned counsel for Respondent has not been able, in a timely fashion, to complete the initial brief in this appeal and would request the additional time in order to do so.


