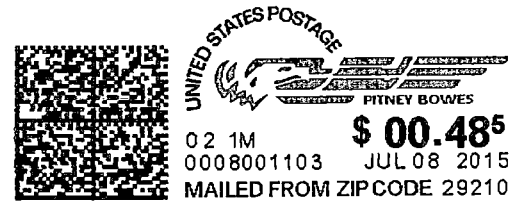
Dear Ms. Kitchings,

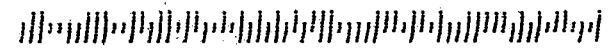
