Dear Counsel:

According to the public index search, you served as counsel for the appellant in the above mentioned appeal. Upon reviewing your client's notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, or the appeal may be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. The proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The proof of service should show that all parties involved in the appeal have been served all documents.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, all parties should be listed on the notice of appeal, and the caption should read as follows:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by a redacted copy of the order(s) and/or sentencing sheet(s) challenged on appeal.

Also, as of today's date the Court has not received notification that the transcript has been ordered or received. Please update the Court with the status of the transcript within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
