ORDER

The order of dismissal in this post-conviction relief case is dated March 31, 2015, and was filed with the clerk of the circuit court on April 6, 2015. Petitioner's counsel has advised this Court that he received written notice of entry of this order on or about April 16, 2015.

Two notices of appeal have been filed in this matter. The first notice of appeal was prepared *pro se* by petitioner, and was received by this Court in an envelope post-marked May 21, 2015. This notice of appeal is undated and the proof of service for this notice of appeal does not contain the date of service. Despite a request from this Court to file an amended proof of service which shows the date of service of the first notice of appeal, no amended proof of service has been filed.

The second notice of appeal is dated June 30, 2015, and was prepared by petitioner's counsel. This notice of appeal was served on June 30, 2015.

As to the first notice of appeal, petitioner has failed to provide sufficient information for this Court to determine if this notice of appeal has been timely served. As to the second notice of appeal, it has not been timely served under Rules 243(b) and 203(b)(1) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by

Rule 221(b), SCACR.
