OF ORDER TO EXCLUDE MATTERS ALLEGED TO NOT BEEN PRESENTED AT LOWER COURT.

APPELLANT RESPECTFULLY MOVE TO HAVE THE THE ABOVE **MOTION** REVIEWED/CONSIDERED BY THIS HONABLE COURT IN AN EFFORT TO RECEIVE A FULL AND FAIR ASSESSMENT OF THE CLAIM INITIALLY FILED IN THE LOWER COURT. WHEN APPELLANT INIATED THIS MATTER HE INCOPERATED THE PREDJUDICE BY AMPLIFING CAPRICIOS ACTS ABROADBY STATING THE RESPONSIBLE PARTIES BEING THE BODY POLITIC., WHICH WOULD INCLUDED THE THE DECISSION MAKERS AND THE PAROLE EXAMINER.

IN THIS CASE IT WAS ALSO CLEARLY SHOWN THAT A STATESMAN USED HIS OFFICE AS A VOICE TO HINDER APPELLANT A CHANCE TO PREVAIL A POSSIBLE SOCIETAL RETURN BASED ON THE RECORD OF BEHAVIOR AND ADJUSTMENT SINCE BEING IMPRISONED. RESPECTING THE COURT AND THE LAW, APPELLANT MERELY WANTS AN OPPORTUNIY TO BE A TAX PAYING PRODUCTIVE CITIZEN. REMORSE HAS BEEN DISPLAYED AND THIS COURT KNOW THAT THE NATURE AND SERIOUS WILL NEVER CHANGE ABSENT AN AMENDMENT TO LAW. IF WHAT IS BEING DONE TO APPELLANT IS FAIR, THEN IT WOULD BE FAIR IF THE COURT ORDERED THE APPELLANT TO BE SHOT BY A FIRING SQUAD ON THE STATEHOUSE STEPS TO APPEASE THE NAYSAYERS WHOSE HEARTS ARE HARDEN WITH HATRED. MANY WHO SEEK TO SEE ME DIE IMPRISONED WAS NOT BORNED IN THE ERA OF MY BAD ACT BUT OPPOSE MY CHANCE TO SHOW MYSELF REFORMED AND REMORSEFUL. 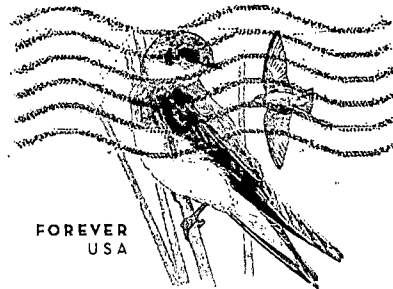
