This letter is to inform the Court that it was recently discovered by the Appellant of this Court, and also the State Supreme Court, the rulings involving the use of the rule of statutory construction "expressio unius" in determining the statute's meaning in the cases of Bennett v. Lexington County Health Services Dist., Inc., not reported in S.E. 2d, 2015 WL 3884262 (S.C. App. 2015); State v. Bolin, 378 S.C. 96, 662 S.E. 2d 38 (2008); State v. Thomas, 372 S.C. 466, 642 S.E. 2d 724 (2007); and Brown v. State, 343 S.C. 342, 540 S.E. 2d 846 (2001). Also the State Supreme Court's holdings in State v. Dingle, 376 S.C. 643, 659 S.E. 2d 101 (2008) about the way parole statutes are to be construed. These rulings are of paramount importance to this appeal in their showing of how the appellate courts interpret the language of statutes to imply meanings to unaddressed provisions by the language legislature uses and also to show whose side issues of parole from statutory language is to be ruled in favor of.

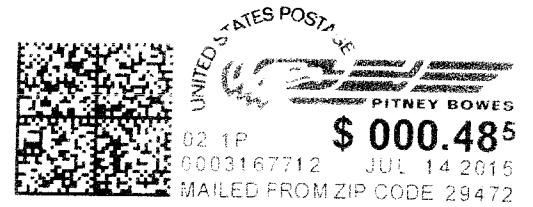
