### FINDINGS OF FACT

The following factual findings are based upon the records contained in the workers' compensation files, stipulations of the parties, the APA submissions, and any other evidentiary submissions:


1. I find that the Claimant has an appointment scheduled with Dr. Tobin on January 12, 2012 that has been set up and authorized by the Defendants.
2. I find that the Defendants have admitted an injury to the left calf with the nature and extent of the injury in dispute and all other body parts have been denied.
3. I find that the hearing will be postponed to a later date and will be rescheduled upon request of either party to determine all issues timely presented to the Commission.
4. I find that the evaluation and opinion of Dr. Tobin on January 12, 2012 is necessary to determine if in fact the Claimant has a direct injury to the left calf and/or left knee and to provide a causation opinion for said injury.

ORDER

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the hearing set for January 10, 2012

is postponed and will be reset upon request of either party as required under the Act. The claim will be returned to general files at this time.
