



Respondent South Carolina Public Charter School District ("District") hereby moves to dismiss the instant appeal. Previously, the case was dismissed because Appellant failed to serve the Record on Appeal and its Reply brief as required. By Order dated June 23, 2015, the appeal was reinstated. However, Appellants' Final Brief and Final Reply Brief was deficient in several ways. By letter dated June 30, 2015, this Court directed Appellant to correct its Final Brief and Final Reply Brief within ten (10) days. Appellant failed to do so, failing to follow this Court's Rules for a second time; and this matter therefore should be dismissed.

Further, the Record on Appeal served by Appellant is replete with errors. For example, pages are out of order or missing, such as pages 212 and 213 of the transcript of the administrative hearing. See R. pp. 235-236. The Record on Appeal also includes confidential information by Appellants in the Record on Appeal. Specifically, Volume IV of the Record on Appeal, as served by Appellant, contains confidential information about students in violation of the Supreme Court's standing order regarding personal data identifiers and the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), 20 U.S.C. § 1232g and its implementing regulations. By letter dated May 20, 2015, the undersigned asked counsel for Appellants to substitute the Volume IV he appears to have filed with the redacted version filed in the Administrative Law Court. However, Appellant's counsel has failed to file the redacted version or respond to the request to do so. This is yet another reason to refuse to reinstate this appeal, but requires correction as soon as possible in any event in order to prevent disclosure of student information.

Therefore, Respondent moves to dismiss the appeal and correct the Record with a redacted version of Volume IV. In the event the appeal is not dismissed, Respondent moves

further to correct the Record on Appeal to include pages 212-213 of the transcript of the administrative proceedings.


