MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Javarias Teague respectfully requests an extension of **final thirty (30) days, until August 12, 2015**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Javarias Teague respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Christopher Miller with the Supreme Court on July 8, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Warren Smith v. State with the Supreme Court on July 2, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Michael Butler with this Court on June 30, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jeremy Sweat v. State on June 26, 2015 with the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Michael Orlando Brown with this Court on June 8, 2015. Counsel filed the reply to the state's return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Vladimir Pantovich v. State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Conrad Slocumb with the Supreme Court on June 1, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Ashley Moore with the Supreme Court on May 19, 2015.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




