That on July 22, 2015 Counsel filed an Emergency Motion to stay the lower court trial based on S.C. Code Ann. Sec. 17-30-110(A).


That on July 22, 2015, Counsel was provided with documentation from the State that resolves the issue of "consent" that is the subject of the July 14th Motion to Suppress.
