
**NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION TO WITHDRAW





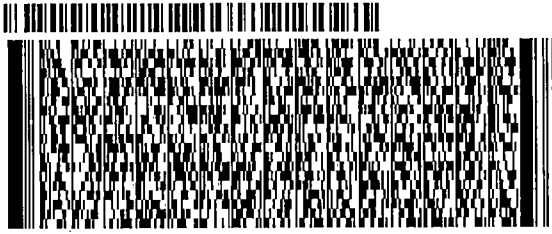
