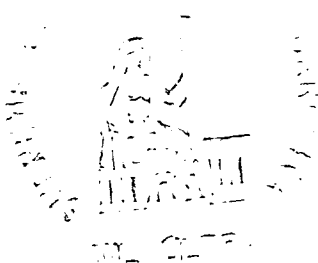



ORDER

By order dated June 2, 2015, this Court dismissed petitioner's notice of appeal for failing to show there was an arguable basis for asserting the determination by the circuit court was improper under Rule 243(c), SCACR. In the order dismissing the notice of appeal, petitioner was prohibited from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court challenging his 1997 convictions for murder, grand larceny, and petit larceny without first obtaining permission of this Court. Petitioner now asks the Court to reconsider that portion of the order limiting his right to file collateral actions in the circuit court. The petition for rehearing is denied.
