Thank you for your letter dated July 21, 2015 informing me the Court will likely schedule this case for oral argument on October 6, 7, 8, 20, or 21, 2015.



AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

By Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court, dated June 10, 2014, Applicant's Post-Conviction Relief action was assigned to this Court following the recusal of the Honorable Edgar W. Dickson from the case by his Order dated June 2, 2014.
