
Dear Mrs. Allen:

On behalf of the Appellant, 3 Chisolm Street Homeowners Association, Inc., this letter provides an update regarding Appellant's Petition for Writ of Certiorari being held in abeyance while the parties attempt to finalize and consummate a settlement that would end this appeal and the underlying case in its entirety. The key terms of the settlement have been agreed to in principal, and we are attempting to resolve a disagreement regarding the wording of a release provision in the agreement. A revised version of the settlement agreement has been submitted to opposing counsel and is presently under their review. I would greatly appreciate the Court granting a final 60-day abeyance of the Petition for Writ of Certiorari while the parties attempt to resolve the one sticking point that would allow for consummation of a settlement.
