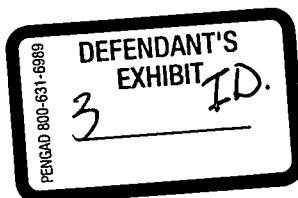

Brief Summary of Incident:

STARR was requested by the Richland County Sheriff's department to bring a cadaver dog to the above address. Upon arrival, I was met by an investigator that stated that the victim was found just outside the front door deceased. They requested to see if K-9 would indicate anywhere in the residence. It was the investigator's opinion, that the victim may have been placed in the residence after she deceased and was in the residence for a period of time before being placed outside.

I broke the k-9 a good distance from the residence and then deployed the k-9 at the house next door to the residence where the victim was located. I released the k-9 from the lead and allowed her to search the area without any direction from me. K-9 did indicate on the spot where the victim was left. I then deployed K-9 into the house at the front door. K-9 searched the lower level of the residence with no alerts or indications. K-9 was brought up to the second level and began searching the residence which had two to three bedrooms. In one of the bedrooms that was to the left of the stairwell, K-9 Mia did alert at the bed and to the right of the bed and the investigator that was following was notified. The bedroom that was to the right of the stairs, K-9 indicated in a walk-in closet. Investigator was also notified. The entire house was searched by K-9 and the two above areas mentioned were the only indications.
