To whom this must concern. My name is Gregory A. Anthony  
I pled out to a Dist<sup>2nd</sup> offense. I received a verbal explanation  
of the inhanement rule. I received a Possesian of Cocaine in 2012.  
The amount of Cocaine was less than 0.10. I was ordered to  
what I think it's called a conditional discharge by the Court. My  
Conditions was as ordered: I must give three Clean drug Screens,  
and pay fines. I Completed all three drug Screens and the fines  
inside of the timeline I was giving to do so. On 10/08/14 I was  
involved in a buy bust by the Edgefeild County Sheriff Department. I  
don't deny exchanging the drugs with the informant. There is video  
evidence of that. The drugs that were exchanged didnot belong to me. I  
just made the deal with the informant. I had at that point been high  
on meth for an unknown number of days. I also had used meth at the  
time of the transaction. The money I received from the informant was  
given to another person. I was to only Profit more drugs for the transaction.  
What I do deny is it being second offense Distubution. I feel  
that my charge of Second offense Dist. could and should have been  
dropped to a first offense Dist. I also feel that my sentace  
was a reflect on my race. What I don't understand is why  
Couldn't my inhanement been dropped. I've been doing  
Some research and found many cases similar to mine, and found  
many cases where the inhanement rule was thrown out.  
On 10/08/14 is the first time I've received a Dist. There aren't  
any other Distributions on my record. Please consider dropping  
the inhanement. I feel I need rehab more than Prison.  
I feel I need a Second chance to get my life clean.  
I am not a serious Criminal who hurts people. I just need  
help with skeletons in my closet, which are "drugs"

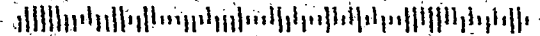
