Although I have not received official notice from either my attorney or the courts of the final decision in my case as of the date of this letter,

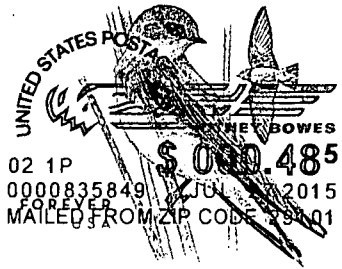
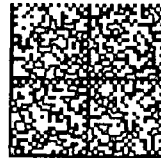
