Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, and should state with specificity the names of the adverse parties that you have served and the names and contact information of counsel representing each party.
- The notice of appeal must indicate whether the parties agreed either in writing or on the record at the hearing that the appeal would be directly to the Court of Appeals and not to the circuit court, as set forth in S.C. Code Ann. § 62-1-308(a) and (l)(Supp. 2014).
