MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Tyrone D. Ellison respectfully requests a **fourth and final** extension of thirty (30) days **until August 26, 2015**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Tyrone D. Ellison respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. John Edward Haynes with the Supreme Court on July 22, 2015. Counsel filed the record on appeal in the case of The State v. Jimmy Turner with this Court on July 22, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Anthony Jackson with the United States Supreme Court on July, 7, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Jeffrey Allen Chapman with this Court on July 1, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Blaton Wakeem Smith with this Court on June 29, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to this Court and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Akeem O. Smith with the Supreme Court on June 22, 2015. Counsel filed the brief of appellant in the case of State v. Tyress Antonio Littlejohn with this Court on June 12, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. James Allen Johnson before this Court on June 9, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Matthew S. Medley with this Court on June 8, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. John E. Haynes with this Court on May 20, 2015. Counsel filed the brief of appellant in the case of State v. Stewart Ard with this Court on May 15, 2015

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension** until **August 26, 2015**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.




