## ORDER

Appellants have filed a notice of appeal from the trial court's denial of their Rule 12(b)(6), SCRCPP, motion. Because an appeal from a denial of a 12(b)(6), SCRCPP, motion is not immediately appealable, this appeal is dismissed. *See Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 339 S.C. 89, 93, 529 S.E.2d 11, 13 (2000) ("Currently, this [c]ourt does not allow immediate appellate review of the denial of any Rule 12(b), SCRCPP[,] motion."). *Huntley v. Young*, 319 SC 559, 560, 462 S.E.2d 860, 861 (1995) ("The denial of a Rule 12(b)(6) motion does not establish the law of the case nor does it preclude a party from raising the issue at a later point or points in the case. Since the order denying the Rule 12(b)(6) motion does not finally decide any issue, it is not directly appealable.").
