JUDGMENT AND ORDER

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After a full hearing on the issues involved herein and consideration of the testimony and records of the Court

SC Court of Appeals

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

That the above-named person is mentally ill and,

- a. Because of his mental condition lacks sufficient insight or capacity to make responsible decisions with respect to his treatment; or
- b. Because of his condition, there is a likelihood of serious harm to himself or others; and therefore,

IT IS ORDERED

- a. That said person continue to be involuntarily hospitalized at Beaufort Memorial Hospital (BMH) until bedspace becomes available at a state mental health facility. If in the clinical judgment of his attending physician at BMH, said person's mental condition has not improved sufficiently to permit his discharge from inpatient treatment by the time bedspace becomes available at a state mental health facility, then, at such time, he shall be transferred to such state mental health facility for continued involuntary inpatient care and treatment as provided in Section 44-17-580, S.C. Code, 1976, as amended; and
- b. That upon his discharge from such involuntary inpatient treatment, whether from BMH or a state mental health facility, said person shall undergo an involuntary out-patient treatment program at Coastal Empire Community Mental Health Center for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months.
- c. And, furthermore, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over said person to insure compliance with this Order, pursuant to Section 44-17-580, S.C. Code, 1976, as amended.

The notice required by Section 23-31-1040 of the South Carolina Code of Laws is provided to the above-named person or her representative, as an attachment hereto.


