
## ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari following the denial of petitioner's application for post-conviction relief.

Petitioner's counsel asserts that the petition is without merit and requests permission to withdraw from further representation. Petitioner has not filed a *pro se* petition. Petitioner did file a motion to withdraw the appeal, but only included the cover page and proof of service, and failed to set forth the grounds for the motion. Rule 240, SCACR. Accordingly, this Court is unable to consider the motion.

After careful consideration of the entire record as required by *Johnson v. State*, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), we deny the petition and grant counsel's request to withdraw.
