

ORDER

The decision of the trial court was affirmed on May 6, 2015. No petition for rehearing was filed as of May 27, 2015, and this Court sent down the remittitur on that day. Appellant has now filed a motion to recall the remittitur and for an extension of time to file a petition for rehearing. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that the remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing with this Court, the remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.


