**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE APPELLANT'S INITIAL BRIEF
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED
IN THE RECORD ON APPEAL**

COMES NOW, Jack B. Swerling, attorney for the Appellant, requesting an extension to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. The Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal is due to be filed on August 7, 2015.

This is the second request for an extension. Counsel is in need of an extension for sixty (60) days for the following reasons:

1. Counsel received another transcript in another matter in the case of State v. Gurley and has a deadline of August 18, 2015 to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal in that case.

As a result of the above circumstances, Appellate counsel requests an additional sixty (60) days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.

Appellate counsel's paralegal, Kellie A. Switzer, has consulted with Salley W. Elliott, Senior Assistant Deputy Attorney General, and she has no objection to any requests for extensions and consents to this request by counsel.

WHEREFORE, counsel prays the Court will grant a sixty (60) day extension, until October 6, 2015, to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.
