My employer, Ms. Cynthia in Human Resources called me and asked me if I wanted to file Workers Compensation. I told her to hold the workers compensation, until I could find out where the source came from. I went to my job, doing my own investigation, since the company did not know who did the crime and when it occurred in the bathroom. Sears did not do any investigation of the crime. I also told her, that I got a cut when I was incarnated and also received a cut on my finger when I was employed at Belks. This could not of happen at either one of these times, because this situation happen after the jailhouse and Belks.

The situation with my case with Sears is that they had Security Officers in the building and no one knows how it happen. I would like to know why there was no security camera showing who enter the restroom.

Sears waited until the limitation time ran out and then they fired me. They stated that I was not coming to work, but I was coming to work for two hours a day.

I am asking the courts to look into this situation for me and give me a chance to plea my case.

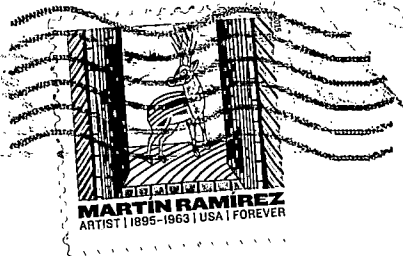
