

ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion requesting to strike three matters that were not included designated by either party and requesting for Appellant to amend the Record on Appeal to include a matter that was designated. Specifically, Respondent seeks for Appellant to include the Magistrate's summary of testimony presented at trial. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion. Additionally, Appellant filed a motion to strike Respondent's designation of the Magistrate's summary of testimony presented at trial. After careful consideration, Respondent's motion is granted, and Appellant's motion is denied. Within twenty days, Appellant shall serve and file an amended Record on Appeal that (1) omits the matters that were not designated by either party¹ and (2) includes the designated matter entitled Magistrate's summary of testimony.
