COME NOW Betty Fisher and Lisa Fisher, Appellants in the above appeals, and, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, move for an extension of time to file and serve the Consolidated Record on Appeal until 30 days after this Court's ruling on Appellants' Joint Motion to Strike Portions of Respondent's Designation of Record.
