Dear Ms. Kitchings:

By letter dated July 15, 2015, the Court informed me that there were deficiencies in the notice of appeal I filed on April 23, 2015, namely the "notice of appeal was not accompanied by a redacted copy of the order(s) and/or sentencing sheet(s) challenged on appeal." I wrote to the Court on July 21, 2015 and enclosed a redacted copy of the sentence sheet related to Appellant's armed robbery conviction. This is the conviction and sentence challenged on appeal in State v. Terrance Seabrook (1), Appellate Case No. 2012-212388. I also explained to the Court that Judge Mullen only made oral findings on the record during Mr. Seabrook's reconstruction hearing and never issued a written order.

However, today, Judge Mullen issued a written order finding the record of Mr. Seabrook's trial was sufficiently reconstructed to allow for meaningful appellate review. In the order, Judge Mullen also adopted all of the oral findings she made on the record during the reconstruction hearing held on April 15, 2015. I have enclosed a clocked copy of Judge Mullen's written order for this Court's convenience.
