

ORDER

The motion for transcript at government expense and the motion to appoint counsel are denied. Instead, if petitioner believes that he is indigent and entitled to appointed counsel, he shall complete the enclosed Affidavit of Indigency and Application for Counsel form, and submit the completed form to the Division of Appellate Defense of the Office of Indigent Defense within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order.¹ If Appellate Defense determines that it will represent petitioner in this post-conviction relief case, it will obtain any necessary transcripts.
