ORDER

The State moves this Court to unseal two exhibits that were admitted into evidence in this matter. The exhibits are transcripts of law enforcement interviews with witnesses. The transcripts were sealed by the court reporter who prepared them, not at the direction of the circuit court, and were not unsealed when admitted into evidence. The Horry County Clerk of Court has informed counsel that the exhibits cannot be released for inclusion in the appendix in this matter absent an order unsealing them. Counsel for petitioner consents to the motion. The motion is granted and the exhibits at issue shall be unsealed.
