**PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Brad A. Day in the Court of Appeals on July 7, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Nearim Blackwell-Selim in this Court on July 1, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Reginald Antonio Nance v. State in this Court on June 26, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Antwon M. Baker, Jr. in this Court on June 22, 2015.



4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty-day extension, until September 21, 2015**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari
