**MEMORANDUM OF LAW IN SUPPORT OF APPELLANT'S MOTION  
TO RECOVER AN AWARD OF COSTS AGAINST RESPONDENT**

**Argument**

Respondents Sofia Mazell, Michael Mazell, Pierceton Mazell and Faith Mazell ("respondents"), by their attorney, William B. Jung, Esq., submits this Memorandum of Law in support of its motion to recover an award of its costs, including an attorney's fee, following this Court's affirmance of the judgment of the circuit court pursuant to Rule 222 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure.

Rule 222 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure provides that a respondent is entitled to recover costs when the Court of Appeals dismisses an appeal. *Id.* By Order dated August, 19, 2015, this Court dismissed Appellant's Appeal.


As set forth in the attached affidavit of William B. Jung, Esq., the appellant's counsel, the appellant incurred the following costs: (1) \$101.18 in printing the respondent's Final Brief. In addition, the respondents seek recovery of an attorney's fee of \$1,000.00 as provided by Rule 222(b). These are all authorized costs under Rule 222 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure, and respondents respectfully submit that the gross sum of \$1,101.18 in costs be taxed against the appellant and in favor of the respondents.

**Conclusion**

For the foregoing reasons, respondents respectfully requests that appellant be taxed \$1,101.18 in costs against the respondent and in favor of the appellant as provided in Rule 222 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure.
