This responds to your motion for reconsideration and to reopen this case dated August 23, 2015, and received by this Court on August 26, 2015.

By order dated July 23, 2015, this Court denied the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case. Therefore, under Rule 221 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, any petition for rehearing had to be actually received by this Court on or before August 7, 2015. Therefore, your motion is untimely.

Further, when no timely petition for rehearing was received, the remittitur was sent to the circuit court on August 10, 2015. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case and no further motions or petitions can be considered by this Court. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Accordingly, no action will be taken on your motion by this Court.

I note that the records of this Court show that you did file several *pro se* documents after my letter of May 18, 2015, informing you that you could file a *pro se* response. This included documents dated May 22, 2015, May 24, 2015, and June 22, 2015. These are the documents that the Court considered as your *pro se* response.
