Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On August 6, 2015, the attorney for the Respondent, Jeremy D. Melville, filed a request for an extension to file the initial brief. Cited as reasons were the vacation of Mark White from June 2-26. 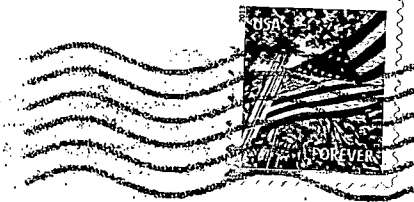
