COME NOW Appellants Live Oak Village Homeowners Association, Inc.; Jennifer McFarland and Carlton Holcombe, by and through their undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and move for an extension of thirty (30) days' additional time to file/serve their initial brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

Presently, by order of this Court filed July 2, 2015, the deadline for Appellants' initial brief and designation of matter is August 7, 2015. On account of work-related and other time commitments (including a family vacation as well as another case in which Appellants' counsel is involved that is presently scheduled for a date-certain trial to begin on August 24th¹) and, again, the undersigned's still relatively recent appearance as Appellants' counsel in this appeal, Appellants respectfully request that this deadline be extended by thirty (30) days (from August 7, 2015), i.e., through

September 8, 2015.² Respectfully, Appellants believe that this relief is consistent with the interests of justice and will not work any undue prejudice upon Respondents.


