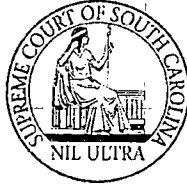

## ORDER

---

The appellant filed this appeal related to his claim for habeas corpus relief in the Supreme Court. The appeal was transferred to this Court for disposition. We now dismiss for several reasons. First, the proof of service accompanying the notice of appeal does not show that the appeal was timely served on the respondent, in violation of Rule 203(b)(1) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). The proof of service shows service upon the trial court judge and not upon a representative of the State. *See Camp v. Camp*, 386 S.C. 571, 574-75, 689 S.E.2d 634, 636 (2010) ("Service of the notice of appeal is a 'jurisdictional requirement, and this Court has no authority to extend or expand the time in which the notice of intent to appeal must be served.'") (quoting *Mears v. Mears*, 287 S.C. 168, 169, 337 S.E.2d 206, 207 (1985)). Second, in response to this Court's letter dated July 7, 2015, requesting a copy of the order or judgment on appeal, the appellant provided a copy of an order signed by the Honorable Tanya A. Gee granting his motion to have this case heard in Richland County. An order affecting venue is not immediately appealable. *Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 339 S.C. 89, 94-95, 529 S.E.2d 11, 14 (2000) (finding that any venue error would be correctable upon appeal after trial and the order affecting venue was not immediately appealable). Finally, the notice of appeal references an order of the Honorable L. Casey Manning. The appellant has failed to provide a copy of that order along with his notice of appeal, in violation of Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(ii), SCACR, and this Court's letter dated July 7, 2015.

Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR.

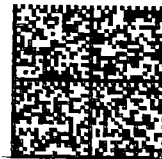
