



ORDER

Appellant/Respondent filed a Petition for Rehearing regarding opinion number 2012-UP-318, filed June 14, 2012. As to whether clear and convincing evidence establishes that Fogle recklessly, willfully, or intentionally invaded Cupstid's rights, the Court grants rehearing. However, the Court does not believe further briefing or oral argument are necessary, and it affirms on the merits. As to all remaining issues, the Court is unable to discover any material fact or principle of law that has been either overlooked or disregarded. Thus, the Court grants rehearing in accordance with the above, withdraws the original opinion, and substitutes the attached opinion.
