


My paralegal recently wrote to you advising that I had a scheduled obligation for November 4th, 2015 – one of the potential oral argument dates for this case.

The purpose of this letter is to further clarify that obligation. My office has a mediation scheduled November 4th in a federal case pending in the Charleston Division. The mediation was rather difficult to schedule as there are multiple parties, and the date had to be cleared by five different attorneys and the mediator. Moreover, we are against a hard deadline to complete the mediation by November 13th, so it will not be possible to reschedule for a later date.
