

ORDER

First, Respondent's motion to compel Appellant to produce a complete record on appeal is granted. Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a supplemental record on appeal that contains an unredacted version of the portions of the transcript that were previously redacted by Appellant unilaterally.

Second, Appellant's motion to seal two of Respondent's exhibits is denied after consideration of the factors and requirements contained in *Ex parte Capital U-Drive-It, Inc.*, 369 S.C. 1, 12, 630 S.E.2d 464, 470 (2006) and Rule 41.1(b), SCRPC.

Finally, Appellant's motion to strike the addition of a footnote in Respondent's final brief is granted. Within ten days of the date of this order, Respondent shall serve and file amended final briefs that omit the contested footnote.
