MOTION TO FILE EXTENSION

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests the Court allow counsel to file a thirty day extension request to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case out of time. In support of this motion counsel submits the following:


1. By letter dated August 28, 2015, the Court notified counsel that the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter was due on August 7, 2015.
2. An extension request was not timely filed on August 7, 2015 because counsel mistakenly believed that her Motion to Hold Appeal from Appellant's Conviction and Sentence in Abeyance Pending Resolution of Appeal from the Ruling Reconstructing the Record of Appellant's Trial filed on June 29, 2015 held the above-referenced appeal in abeyance until the

Court acted on the motion. This Court granted Appellant's motion by order dated August 21, 2015.

3. Counsel mistakenly believed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter was due sixty days from the date of the Court's August 21, 2015 order granting Appellant's motion to hold his appeal from his conviction and sentence in abeyance pending the resolution of his appeal from the order reconstructing the record.

Based upon the above showing, counsel respectfully requests this Court grant the request and allow counsel to file a thirty day extension for the filing of the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case out of time.
