



## ORDER



The petition for rehearing is denied with respect to the harmless error issue. The petition for rehearing is granted with respect to the issue of whether this Court should remand this case to the court of appeals to consider the arguments the court of appeals did not reach because it found the prior convictions issue was dispositive. The parties are directed to commence briefing on the remand issue, and are specifically directed to address the question of the propriety of a remand to the court of appeals in light of Respondent's failure to address those arguments in his brief to this Court. Respondent's brief shall be due fifteen days from the date of this order, after which Petitioner's response brief will become due fifteen days following; Respondent shall file a reply brief, if any, within ten days following the filing date for Petitioner's response brief.
