MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel for Derrick George respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. 

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Corey William Brown with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2015. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Willie James Poole v. State of South Carolina with this Court on August 17, 2015..

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.




