ORDER

Respondent has moved for leave to file a motion with the circuit court under Rule 60(a), SCRCP, to correct clerical mistakes in its prior motion for default judgment and the circuit court's order of default judgment. The motion is denied. *See Dion v. Ravenel, Eiserhardt Assocs.*, 316 S.C. 226, 230, 449 S.E.2d 251, 253 (Ct. App. 1994) ("Generally, a clerical error is defined as a mistake in writing or copying."); *id.* at 230, 449 S.E.2d at 253-54 (recognizing a court may not change the scope of a judgment through the correction of a clerical error).
