This matter comes before this Court for an Order setting restitution in the above-listed cases, be paid by the Defendant, Richard P. Krochmal, as a condition of his probationary sentence. The Court held a hearing in the matter on March 30, 2015, and subsequently requested memorandums of law be provided by both parties setting out any relevant law and/or statutory provisions in support of their respective positions on the proper restitution amount to be ordered in connection with the above-listed indictments.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, and the law and analysis presented by both parties, the Court determines that restitution shall be set in the amount of Thirty Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$30,100.00). Such restitution shall be imposed as a condition of the Defendant's probation, which is currently serving, and shall be collected by the Department of Probation, Pardon, and Parole Services.
