I am in receipt of your correspondence of September 3, 2015, in regard to the above-referenced matter. Please refer to the following section of the Court Reporter Manual as promulgated by the South Carolina Supreme Court:

The court reporter shall transcribe and deliver all transcripts no later than 60 days after the date of the request unless an extension has been approved by Court Administration. (See § XIV (D), and Rule 607, SCACR (See Appendix 4). The due date will be determined by the date the court reporter receives the request. It is therefore recommended that the requestor's envelope showing the postmark be retained. In the case of court reporters who require advance payment, the due date will be 60 days after payment is received by the court reporter.

Your advance payment was received in my office on July 17, 2015. Therefore, the due date will be 60 days from July 17, 2015, absent a request for an extension by the court reporter. Should you have any questions in this regard, please contact me at the above address. Thank you for your inquiry.
