

I am in receipt of your correspondence dated September 1, 2015. Please accept this as my response to your inquiry concerning the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter.

As my previous correspondence to you indicated, there is an issue as to who is representing Mr. Chisolm concerning his SVP matter as well as his appeal. I was notified several months ago that I was no longer Mr. Chisolm's appointed attorney and that Mr. Falk was now assigned to this matter. Please see enclosed Order I have provided for your convenience.

I immediately contacted Judge Dennis and copied all appropriate parties as well as Mr. Chisolm. Mr. Chisolm does not want any other attorney but myself to continue with his matter but due to indigent clients not being able to "choose" their appointed counsel, Judge Dennis has asked that all the parties involved (including OID counsel) be available along with Mr. Chisolm on September 28th in Charleston to discuss who will in fact continue to represent Mr. Chisolm in his SVP matter as well as the pending Appeal.

If after the hearing on September 28th, Judge Dennis finds that I should remain as his counsel, I will promptly prepare and file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the form of a McCoy (Anders) Petition.

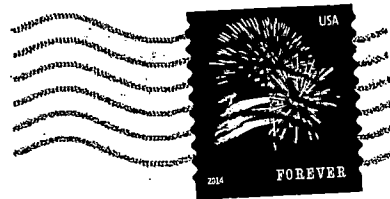
