MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. 

On August 10, 2015, counsel filed the brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Otis Robinson with this Court. On July 29, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Wayland Purnell with this Court. On July 29, 2015, counsel also filed the brief of petitioner in Luther Garner v. State with the Supreme Court. On July 27, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Wayland Purnell with this Court. On July 20, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter In the matter of the care and treatment of Dewey Chadwick with this Court. 4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


