For me to receive any type of care, traveling to and from, medicines, cost money, is not given free. The damage that was placed on me from the respondent is an atrocity of nothing but a life of daily pain. It is inconceivable for me to understate that one who is regarded by law to help people, turn around and does the greatest harm to another. I, the Appellant, have lived a life of pain over 4 years, which now that pain has worsened. It has become unbearable for me to deal

with on a daily basis, taking medicines to control or minimize the pain. It is now at a new level of extreme agony for me. According to Dr. Robert Kneece, of Columbia, the infection in the facial nerves is back. Problems are developing to me that medicine cannot control. On September 25, 2015, of this month, I am going to MUSC, Medical University of South Carolina, to be prep for surgery (Trigeminal Neuralgia – Nerve Damage), for relief from pain. It is now at the point where the face swells on and off, especially when I'm trying to sleep. Swelling of the tongue/choking me at night, constant swelling in the right ear, very painful. Throat and right side of the neck hurts more. Pain in the corner of the right eye and the nose burns with intense sensitivity to pain. My face hurts every day.

Considering all that is happening to me, for one to claim that they didn't initiate the problem and continue to deny what their actions did, needs to return to the School where their License was issued. The damages from this Dentist should be handed to me on a silver platter (smile), however I know what I am asking for is far less than my life being dwelled away, because of the severity from my pains. I asked for \$2,000,000.00, in compensatory and 7,000,000.00 in punitive, because I must suffer. It is Chronic.


To be included in the record of Appeal;


