The trial of this case was held in the County of Aiken in the Court of Common Pleas the week of August 31, 2015. A jury of citizens from Aiken County heard this case pursuant to a request for a jury trial filed by the State. Senior Assistant Attorney General James G. Bogle, Jr. represented the State. Aimee J. Zmroczek, Esquire, represented the Respondent. The jury having heard the presentation of the evidence made the following findings of fact pursuant to South Carolina Code Sections 44-48-90 and 44-48-100:

The State has proven beyond a reasonable doubt that Respondent, Roy Lee Wade, is a sexually violent predator as that term is defined in South Carolina Code Section 4448-30.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT

- (a) Respondent is committed to the Department of Mental Health for his long-term control, care and treatment;
- (b) Respondent is to be immediately taken into custody by the Aiken County Sheriff's Department and transported to the secure facility of the South Carolina Department of Mental Health, at 4460 Broad River Road, Columbia, SC 29210. The Sheriff is to transport Respondent on such scheduled date as it coordinates with the Department of Mental Health.
