This statement pertains to incidents that occurred at Kershaw Correction Institution that have/is affected appellant condition of confinement and appellants ability to litigate two court case.

I believe Kershaw Contraband official and Sgt Hunt are acting with a personal vendetta when conducting contraband searches of personal property and legal material. Since February of this year the Kershaw Contraband official and Sgt Hunt have conducted abnormal contraband searches of personal property and legal material.

On 5-16-15, Sgt Hunt conducted a contraband search of personal property and legal material.

On 7-29-15, Sgt Hunt conducted a contraband search of personal property and legal material.

On 8-26-15, Sgt Hunt conducted a contraband search of personal property and legal material.

Therefore, the above incidents have affected ~~the~~ appellants ability to litigate two court case, Campbell vs. S.C.D.C. Appellate case No 2014-01981 and P.C.R. case 2014 CP 34-37.

On June 10, 2015, I wrote a letter to S.C. Court of Appeals and to Attorney Daniel Brooks at S.C.D.C. office of General Counsel. This letter ~~contents~~<sup>contents</sup> served to address some of the above concerns.

However, since the filing of Appellants June 10, 2015 Letter, Kershaw Contraband officer have conducted abnormal contraband searches more frequently.

Therefore, their conduct has resulted in less time for appellant to attend scheduled Law Library visitation time for research and there is no other place in this institution that appellant could visit to make the corrections to Appellant Initial Brief.

On 8-26-15, I spoke with Shift Captain Goodwin and Kershaw Institution Major, Ford, in regards to the above concerns. I asked for protective custody. However, I was not allowed to attend scheduled Law Library visitation time for 8-26-15 and 8-28-15.
